# RESOLUTION TO ADOPT NEW ACADEMIC RECOGNITION SYSTEM BEGINNING WITH THE GRADUATING CLASS OF 2019

WHEREAS, as the Canton City School District (the District) transitions to a more unified, systemically aligned school system, one of the areas that in need of refinement is the way student academic achievement is recognized at the high school; and

WHEREAS, the District currently uses a norm-referenced system that ranks each student within his/her graduating class based on their Grade Point Average; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to create a criterion-referenced system that will enable students to set firm academic goals based on their own course selection and academic performance. A criterion-referenced system will incentivize students with high grade point averages to explore the arts, Career Tech classes, and other enriching electives without impacting their academic status while simultaneously incentivizing all students to explore more rigorous class offerings such as college classes; and

WHEREAS, it is important that the grading scales for courses are aligned with the academic rigor of the course. Specifically, courses with the potential to earn college credit should be on a higher grading scale than non-college credit earning courses and advanced courses should be on a higher grading scale than non-advanced courses; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education previously adopted a resolution to maintain the current academic recognition system for current Timken and McKinley students through the class of 2018 to ensure that no student is penalized as a result of the consolidation to one high school; now

THEREFORE, be it resolved, that effective with the Class of 2019, all courses with the potential to earn college credit (College Credit Plus, Advanced Placement) will be graded on a 5.0 scale. All advanced, but non-college credit earning courses, will be graded on a 4.5 scale with all remaining courses graded on a 4.0 scale; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Canton City School District will adopt a Summa system for academic recognition effective with the Class of 2019. The academic recognition designations shall be as follows:

- Summa Cum Laude Students who graduate with a 4.3 or above GPA;
