# RESOLUTION TO RECONFIGURE THE CANTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT MIDDLE SCHOOL ATHLETIC PROGRAM BEGINNING WITH THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR

WHEREAS, there is a need to reconfigure the middle school athletic program to achieve financial efficiency and competitive balance; and

WHEREAS, the reconfiguration will result in a savings from a reduction in coaching staff, an ease of facility usage/scheduling, and more and better competition for student-athletes; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the following configuration for middle school athletics is recommended beginning with the 2016-2017 school year;

- The District will have two (2) Middle School Athletic Programs in the following sports: Football, Volleyball, Girls Basketball, and Fall Cheerleading.
  - Altitude Academy @ Crenshaw (Crenshaw) and STEAMM Academy @ Hartford (Hartford) will be combined into one program; all students enrolled at Crenshaw and Hartford shall participate in this program. This program will officially be known as "Canton Red."
  - C2RA @ Lehman (Lehman) will be the other program. All students enrolled at Lehman shall participate in the Lehman program. This program will officially be known as "Canton Black."
  - Students from Early College Academy @ Souers (ECA) and the Arts Academy @ Summit (Arts) will have the option to participate on either the Red or Black team, subject to procedures established by the district.
  - There will be up to 40 Cheerleaders (20 per program).
- The District may have up to four (4) Middle School Boys' Basketball programs. Hartford, Lehman and Crenshaw (Canton Red, Black and White) shall have basketball programs. Students from ECA and Arts will have the option to choose whether they participate at Hartford, Lehman or Crenshaw subject to procedures established by the district. An additional team may be created at Lehman (Gray) if necessary.
- The number of overall basketball teams shall determine the number of cheerleading participants.
- The District will have one (1) Wrestling, Boys Track, Girls Track, Boys Cross Country, Girls Cross Country, Boys Soccer and Girls Soccer program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that effective beginning with the 2016-17 school year, the Canton City School District shall reconfigure the middle school athletic programs as recommended above.
