A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING AN AMENDMENT TO THE OHIO SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATION 2017 LEGISLATIVE PLATFORM

WHEREAS, the Canton City School District is a member of the Ohio School Boards Association, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio School Boards Association consistently advocates on behalf of its member school districts with legislators in the State of Ohio, and

WHEREAS, part of that advocacy includes a "legislative platform" that is reviewed and amended each year by OSBA member school districts, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly amended H.B. 70 June 24, 2015, which was passed by both chambers in a single day and without prior notification or hearing, subsequently described by media accounts as "expediently and in secret," language that has become known as the "Youngstown Plan," and

WHEREAS, the Governor signed the legislation into law July 16, 2015, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio School Boards Association responded with a statement calling the measure a "threat to elected school boards," adding, "Indeed, it is an affront to every school board member in Ohio and all locally elected officials," and

WHEREAS, the amendment undermines the constitutional and democratic principles of local control of school districts through election of a Board of Education which then appoints a Superintendent and Treasurer accountable to that Board, by creating a Chief Executive Officer position to be appointed by entities that are not accountable to local electors, and

WHEREAS, said CEO has broad and sweeping powers, substantially more power than the Superintendent and Treasurer, and that such power is unchecked, and includes the power to unilaterally determine curriculum, set the configuration of schools, modify policies, nullify contracts including Collective Bargaining Agreements, and

WHEREAS, the legislation further subjugates the democratic process by granting mayors the authority to appoint members of Boards of Education, which can also be a conflict of interest, and

WHEREAS, the legislation promotes charter schools, which usurp resources from public schools and have been proven, as a whole, to be less successful academically than the public school districts they supplant, and

WHEREAS, the legislation is a threat to all public school districts in Ohio, it first singles out and targets those with diverse, economically challenged populations,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, on May 22, 2017, the Canton City School District Board of Education recommends the following modifications to the legislative platform under "Academic distress commission" of the <u>School governance</u> plank: "OSBA supports the repeal of Amended Substitute House Bill Number 70 as enacted by the 131st General Assembly" and "OSBA opposes all academic distress commissions, as defined and implemented under Amended Substitute House Bill Number 70 enacted by the 131st General Assembly or any similar creation that interferes with the governance of public school districts by elected Boards of Education."
