History & Background

Back in the 1940's, 50's and 60's, several schools in the Canton City School District boasted orchestra programs. One of the largest being the Timken Vocational High School Orchestra. With the band, they would put on their annual Spring Concert anywhere between the end of April or beginning of May. These combined concerts started in 1945. It is uncertain when this tradition fell out of favor.

With the creation of one, unified high school in Canton, we were able to restart the orchestra program at the high school level. It had already been revived at the middle school level at the Arts Academy at Summit.

The Arts Academy began their orchestra program in 2005 with roughly 35-40 students. They also began a guitar program at this time as well. Not until this school year was it possible for high school students to participate in strings.

During the 2016-2017 school year, McKinley High School started their own guitar program to feed off the Arts Academy. Starting with roughly 50 students between both campuses, the guitar program is now 70 strong. They have been invited to perform across Northeast Ohio at several colleges and universities.

Most recently they have performed at the Kent State Stark Guitar Festival and Solo & Ensemble competition. Just today they performed at the Cleveland Institute of Music and on Thursday they will be performing at The University of Akron's Guitar Day.

The orchestra program is also seeing a tremendous amount of growth district wide. Before this year, the only school that offered an orchestra class was the Arts Academy. We have recently expanded this to three additional middle schools and you can now find orchestras at Early College Academy @ Souers, C2RA @ Lehman and Altitude Academy @ Crenshaw.

What started off two years ago as a few students playing violin in the high school choir room has blossomed into a program that we hope continues to grow for years to come. Currently, in the middle school string program there are 102 orchestra members.

We are also excited that we have been able to extend the guitar program into the Early College Academy @ Souers and C2RA @ Lehman All of these small additions will have a positive impact not only on our school culture but our community as well.
