Speech & Debate

Alan B. Rubinstein Award for Excellence in Forensics

This award is named after Alan B Rubinstein, former coach of McKinley Speech and Debate and member of the OHSSL Coaches' Hall of Fame. It is given each year to outstanding senior speech members who show excellence in competition as well as leadership skills. The winners each receive an individual plaque, as well as having their names added to a perpetual plaque kept in McKinley's trophy case.

National Forensic League Ruby Awards

Given to less than one percent of all graduating high school seniors, this award consists of an engraved frame and a pin or pendant set with a number of rubies each signifying accumulated excellence in speech and debate, this award is a rare honor.

McKinley Speech and Debate Hall of Fame

An award given to students who achieve one of the following: Qualify to the State Tournament four consecutive years, reach at least the semifinal round of the State Tournament, or reach the final round of the National Qualifying Tournament.

National Forensic League Honor Cords

These honor cords are given to graduating members of the speech team who have gained membership into the National Forensic League and have competed in either OHSSL District or State, or NFL District or National Tournaments.

This award is given for Archie Griffin, an Ohio native and the only two-time recipient of the Heisman Trophy for football.
