## STARK STATE COLLEGE A HISTORY OF EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE

Stark State College was founded in 1960 when computerization and the development of new technologies and companies created a need for well-educated, highly trained employees with two-year college degrees. Stark State College was born out of that need. Well-respected in the community, Stark State College plays a vital role in the economic growth and development of the region through its strong tradition of providing educational and training services to employers and residents.

Today, Stark State College offers over 250 associate degrees, one-year certificates and career enhancement certificates in business and entrepreneurial studies, education, liberal arts, mathematics, engineering technologies, information technology, health and public services, and sciences.

Degrees awarded are the associate of arts, associate of science, associate of applied science, associate of applied business and associate of technical studies. These degrees prepare our graduates for career success as they move directly into the workforce or choose to continue their education in pursuit of a baccalaureate degree. A wide range of short-term career enhancement certificates help employees improve skills and gain a competitive edge in a society with rapidly changing technology. Career enhancement certificates lead to associate degrees and one-year certificates in various fields of study.

Community and business partnerships are vital to Stark State's success. The College has developed an outstanding reputation among business and industry for its willingness to aggressively enhance workforce development activities in support of emerging business needs. A few of Stark State's public/private partnerships include LG Fuel Cell Systems (formerly Rolls Royce Fuel Cell Systems Inc.), The Timken Co., Diebold Nixdorf, Contained Energy, Lockheed Martin, Kohler Container Co. and Ariel Corporation.

The Stark State College Foundation is a non-profit, tax-exempt organization that provides financial support beyond that obtained through student fees and state allocations. The Foundation exists solely to benefit the students and programs of Stark State College and assists the College in reaching a higher level of excellence in serving the educational needs of our community.

## THE ACADEMIC PROCESSIONAL

The academic processional precedes the graduation ceremonies and reflects the early origins of education. To recognize the achievements of their students, higher education institutions in America hold an official commencement, during which time students are awarded appropriate degrees at the completion of their studies.

Academic costume has a history of nearly eight centuries. As students in medieval Europe organized into guilds, they developed distinctive costumes for various degrees. Differences among this garb appeared mainly in the hood, which is derived from the cloak. Hoods are now ornamental and are draped over the shoulders and down the back. The hood is faced with colors, which denote the field of study represented by the wearer's degree. The colors of the lining are those of the college or university by which the degree was granted.

In Europe, a professor generally wears the type of garment customary in the university where he or she is lecturing. In the U.S., professors continue to wear the gown and hood of the university where they received the highest degree.

The cap or "mortarboard" originated at Oxford. In Europe, one sees caps of other sorts, but in the U.S., caps are generally flat and square-shaped. Attached to a button on top of the "mortarboard" is a tassel. Tassels for associate and bachelor's degrees are black. Tassels for master's degrees are black or a color appropriate to the major field of study. For doctoral degrees, tassels are black or golden. The tassel is moved from the right side of the cap to the left side after receiving a degree and worn on the left side by those who have received a degree.

The various colors of the hoods signify the field of study in which the degree is earned. For example: white – arts, letters and humanities; olive – business and commerce; light blue – education; orange – engineering; purple – law; golden yellow – science; apricot – nursing; lemon – library science; pink – music; and green – medicine.

## DISTINCTION AND HIGH DISTINCTION

Graduates who have demonstrated outstanding accomplishment in their technologies will be announced as graduating either with "Distinction" or "High Distinction."

Graduates who have a grade point average of 3.4 or above as of the end of fall semester 2017 will graduate with Distinction.

Graduates who have a grade point average of 3.8 or above as of the end of fall semester 2017 will graduate with High Distinction.

The level of distinction is based on the grade point average at the end of the semester preceding graduation. If the level of distinction changes after final grades are posted for the graduating semester, the student's academic record will be updated.

## HISTORY AND TRADITION OF THE MACE

The ceremonial mace that is used in college and university commencement exercises was originally a weapon designed to protect kings that dates back to 12,000 B.C. Throughout history, the mace also has been a symbol of royalty and justice. Though maces traditionally were used as weapons, Scottish maces are musical instruments and have been and continue to be used as instruments of wartime music and military bands. The mace also is a symbol of academic authority. In commencement ceremonies, the mace is carried before the president and dignitaries who are seated at the platform where the graduates receive their diplomas.

## THE CONSTRUCTION AND SYMBOLISM OF THE STARK STATE MACE

Stark State College's commencement mace is handcrafted from cherry wood, salvaged from a fallen tree on Stark State's campus. The mace is 50 inches long and weighs 16 pounds. It was turned in March of 2006 by local craftsman Merle Weber. The Massillon Plaque Company fabricated the metal castings on the mace to the College's specifications.

The foundation for the head of the mace is constructed of "Ohio flint," a crypto-crystalline quartz and the state's official gemstone. The mace is crowned on both the obverse and reverse sides, with the official logo of the College.

Four brass bands on the staff are engraved with the four names of the College and the dates associated with those names, capturing the College's history and development since its founding in 1960. Three cast-brass plates affixed to the large barrel section near the top of the mace symbolize the College's national and state affiliations. The first cast brass plate depicts the United States flag. Symbolizing our state college status, the next casting displays the state motto, "With God All Things are Possible," and the final casting displays the Great Seal of the State of Ohio.

## ALUMNI HALL OF FAME 2018 INDUCTEE DEANDREA L. BELL

Deandrea Bell is the 2018 inductee into Stark State College's Alumni Hall of Fame in recognition of professional and community achievements.

Bell, originally of Canton and now of Akron, earned a Stark State College associate degree in nursing in 2009, graduating as a member of Phi Theta Kappa honor society. A registered nurse, she also holds a BSN from The University of Akron and has done post-graduate work at Walsh University and at Aspen University, where she is pursuing an MSN/MBA.

Currently serving as cardiac telemetry unit nursing director/patient services at Cleveland Clinic Akron General, during her nursing career she has earned Nursing Excellence, Spirit and Nurse Educator awards. She also earned a National Black Nurses Association 40 Under 40 Award. She was inducted as a nursing leader by Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society of Nursing.

She has credentials as a nurse executive, medical-surgical international business and organizational leadership, and has worked as an adjunct instructor at Walsh University and as a staff nurse at Akron General Medical Center/ Cleveland Clinic Main.

Bell has served as a community and academic mentor, volunteered at the Haven of Rest Ministries and free clinics, participated in Hope International mission trips to the Dominican Republic and helped install community libraries at Akron Public Schools as president of her Tony Gorant Community Leadership Class.

Her many professional and community memberships include Leadership Akron; Tony Gorant Community Leadership Institute, participant and past class president; the Ohio Hospital Association; Ohio Organization of Nurse Executives; Akron Black Nurses Association, Inc., Akron chapter vice president; and she is a member of the Board of Directors of Weaver Industries.



## COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER DAVID BAKER

David Baker came to Canton as president of the Pro Football Hall of Fame with a reputation as an experienced and passionate leader in business, politics and sports. He is dedicated to inspiring exponential growth in individuals and organizations of excellence that seek to make a difference in their communities and the world.

In his four years at the Hall, the organization's net assets more than doubled, and it was voted in USA TODAY as the Best Attraction for Sports Fans. Baker, a recipient of the prestigious March of Dimes Sports Leadership Award for 2017, also is spearheading the Johnson Controls Hall of Fame Village, an \$899 million mixed-use project which will result in the first-ever sports and entertainment "smart city."

He earned a bachelor's degree in English literature and criticism from the University of California at Irvine and his juris doctorate from the Pepperdine School of Law where he served as editor-in-chief of the Pepperdine Law Review.

He played professional basketball in Switzerland and worldwide with a Christian basketball team. Elected mayor and councilman of Irvine, California, the country's first master-planned city, Baker also served for 12 years as the commissioner of the Arena Football League. Additionally, he was the managing partner for Union Village in Nevada, a \$1.3 billion mixed-use project that was the first integrated health village in the world.

Baker and his wife, Colleen, have four children and eight grandchildren.

With a focus on the Hall of Fame's five core values – commitment, integrity, courage, respect and excellence – David Baker leads by example at "the most inspiring place on earth."
