RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE OHIO SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATION LEGISLATIVE PLATFORM TO BE ABLE TO ADVOCATE FOR STATE REPORT CARDS THAT ARE MORE REFLECTIVE OF DISTRICT ACHIEVEMENT AND EQUITY

Whereas the State of Ohio Department of Education issues annual report cards to school districts: and

Whereas letter grades used by the current report cards correlate to average median income of school districts instead of actual student achievement independent of school district teaching and learning strength; and

Whereas state policy is to use the letter grade on school district report cards punitively; and

Whereas school districts in the most impoverished communities with the most diverse student populations by race, ethnicity, and legacy familial education attainment are often doing the best educational work while being simultaneously punished by the current report card; and

Whereas the Canton City School District has been in a leadership role in a work group comprised of multiple school districts convened by the OSBA Urban Network in 2018-19; and

Whereas that working group developed a model state report card that meets all federal requirements, eliminates the punitive letter grade system in favor of measuring equity, actual student growth and reduces the over reliance on high stakes testing; and

Whereas the state legislature has signaled it will maintain control over what goes into state report cards; and

Whereas it has become apparent that the current OSBA legislative platform is insufficient to direct the association's legislative activities toward enactment of a more appropriate report card; and

Whereas maintenance of the *status quo* is an existential threat to the Canton City School District and similarly situated school districts;

Therefore be it resolved that the Board of Education of the Canton City School District is asking the 2022 Ohio School Boards Association to amend the Legislative Platform as follows:

Replace all current report card related language with:

OSBA supports legislation that

- * Ends the A-F rating system in favor of one that favors Equity and reports scores and achievement trends over time and a continuum of meeting targets and supports.
- * Moves toward a varied system of assessments that allows students to demonstrate academic competency and mastery in ways beyond state standardized tests.
- * Acknowledges local choice in gauging non-academic knowledge and skills.
- * Minimizes the impact of economic status on achievement.
- * Reports and rates school district work together with parents, caregivers and community partners to help schools meet the needs of the whole child.
- * Reports and rates district early learning opportunities and how school districts use early learning to expand access to quality early learning experiences.
- * Ensures high school students identify paths to future success, and gives students multiple ways to demonstrate the knowledge, skills, and dispositions necessary for high school graduation and beyond.
- * Moves deliberations over report card modifications to governmental bodies with expertise in educational best practices.

OSBA opposes legislation that

- * In any way favors communities with high median income in determining academic performance.
