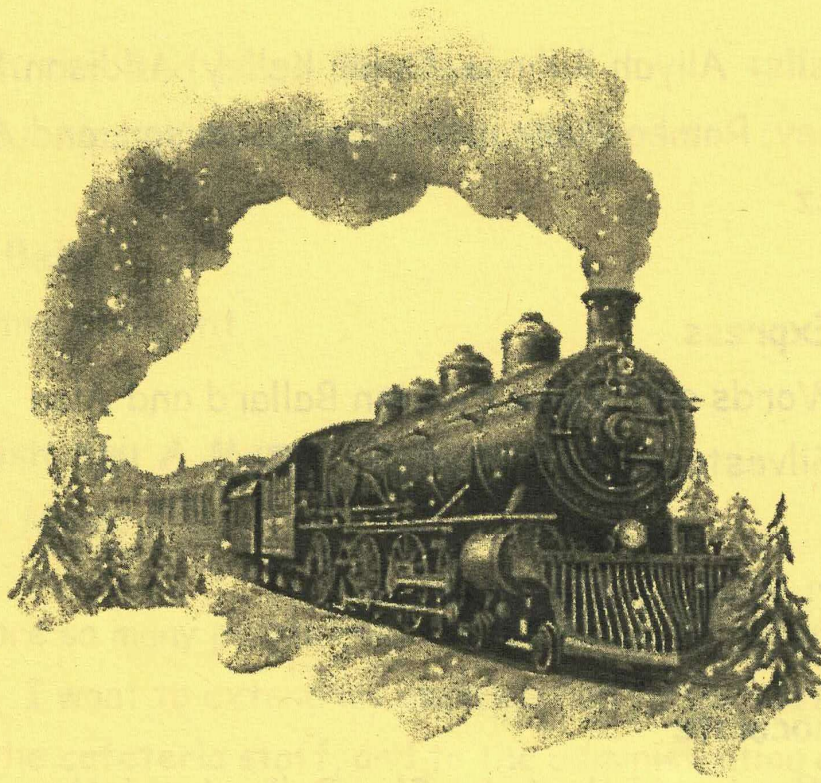

If you have to leave, please do so when there is a break in the music selections and do not leave when a group is performing.
